Date	Sites
Dec. 6 (overnight at JUC)	Arrival in Jerusalem
Dec. 7 (overnight in Cairo)	Depart JUC's campus, travel through Negev and Sinai
Dec. 8 (overnight in Cairo)	Giza Pyramids including the Sphinx, Papyrus Institute, The Grand Egyptian Museum
Dec. 9 (overnight on sleeper train)	Memphis, Sakkara, Djoser's pyramid complex, pyramid of Teti, tombs of Mereruka and Ptah-hotep, pyramids of Dashur
Dec. 10 (overnight in Aswan)	High Dam, Elephantine Island, Philae Temple, and camel ride to St. Simeon Monastery
Dec. 11 (overnight in Luxor)	Temples of Kom Ombo, Edfu, nighttime visits to Luxor temple complex.

Dec. 12 (overnight in Luxor)	Colossae of Memnon, Valley of the Kings, Deir el-Bahri, Medinet Habu (morturary temple of Rameses III), Deir el Medina (workers village), Ramesseum
Dec. 13 (overnight on sleeper train)	Karnak temple complex, Luxor Museum, road of the Sphinx, Luxor markets
Dec. 14 (overnight in Cairo)	Egyptian Museum at Tahrir, Coptic Cairo including Abu Sarga, the Hanging Church, Ben Ezra Synagogue, and Church of St. George.
Dec. 15 (overnight in St. Catherine)	Travel from Cairo to an overlook of the delta, then through the Sinai to the area of St. Catherine's and Mt. Sinai.
Dec. 16 (overnight at JUC)	Sunrise hike to Mount Sinai, St. Catherine's Monastery, return to Jerusalem
Dec. 17	Departure from Jerusalem
