Egypt Field Study Sample Itinerary*

Date	Sites
Dec. 6 (overnight at JUC)	<i>Arrival in Jerusalem</i>
Dec. 7 (overnight in Cairo)	<i>Depart JUC's campus, travel through Negev and Sinai</i>
Dec. 8 (overnight in Cairo)	<i>Giza Pyramids including the Sphinx, Papyrus Institute, The Grand Egyptian Museum</i>
Dec. 9 (overnight on sleeper train)	<i>Memphis, Sakkara, Djoser's pyramid complex, pyramid of Teti, tombs of Mereruka and Ptah-hotep, pyramids of Dashur</i>
Dec. 10 (overnight in Aswan)	<i>High Dam, Elephantine Island, Philae Temple, and camel ride to St. Simeon Monastery</i>
Dec. 11 (overnight in Luxor)	<i>Temples of Kom Ombo, Edfu, nighttime visits to Luxor temple complex.</i>

Dec. 12 (overnight in Luxor)	<i>Colossae of Memnon, Valley of the Kings, Deir el-Bahri, Medinet Habu (mortuary temple of Rameses III), Deir el Medina (workers village), Ramesseum</i>
Dec. 13 (overnight on sleeper train)	<i>Karnak temple complex, Luxor Museum, road of the Sphinx, Luxor markets</i>
Dec. 14 (overnight in Cairo)	<i>Egyptian Museum at Tahrir, Coptic Cairo including Abu Sarga, the Hanging Church, Ben Ezra Synagogue, and Church of St. George.</i>
Dec. 15 (overnight in St. Catherine)	<i>Travel from Cairo to an overlook of the delta, then through the Sinai to the area of St. Catherine's and Mt. Sinai.</i>
Dec. 16 (overnight at JUC)	<i>Sunrise hike to Mount Sinai, St. Catherine's Monastery, return to Jerusalem</i>
Dec. 17	<i>Departure from Jerusalem</i>
